## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:**

**What do I need to do to register my child?** First you need to pay your \$50 non-refundable registration fee to secure your spot and registration form. After you turn this in you will be given an enrollment packet. These papers are located on our website at [www.NoahsParkPreschool.com](http://www.NoahsParkPreschool.com) or in the church office.

**What qualifications do your teachers need to teach?** Our teachers are state certified and meet all state child care requirements. Each teacher has different backgrounds above what the state requires. Our teachers have either a Bachelors in Early Elementary Education, Bachelors in Child Development or Child Development credits beyond what the state requires. Each teacher also has extensive experience in ministry with young children.

**What is the Teacher/ Student ratio?** We have no more than 14 students in each class. There is a lead teacher and a teacher's aide in each class. Parents are also always welcome to volunteer in the classroom.

**Does my child need to be potty trained?** Yes, your child needs to be fully potty trained to be able to attend the class. We have a bathroom with a child size toilet inside our classroom that is easily accessible to the children.

**How do I pay for tuition?** Tuition can be paid at [www.NoahsParkPreschool.com](http://www.NoahsParkPreschool.com) or by check the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month. Please make the checks out to NorthPark Community Church. You can pay any way you like as long as your tuition is up to date such as trimester or for the full year.

**What does my child need to bring to school?** We provide everything for your child. The \$75 annual supply fee covers the supplies, curriculum and snack. We ask that each child wears closed toe shoes and brings a water bottle with their name on it.

**Can a family member or myself help in the classroom?** Of course! We love help in the classroom and the children love having you there. The state does require that a TB Test be on file, you sign the visitors log and if you are here more than 13 hours then we need to have you fingerprinted for the preschool.

**Are there events during the year?** Yes, we have many events during the year where siblings and family can come. We have Field Trips, Pretend Party, Thanksgiving Feast, Christmas Performance, Easter, Mother's Day Tea, Graduation and more.

**CURRICULUM:** Biblical concepts, prayer and character traits are woven into our curriculum daily to meet the current interests and needs of the children. We incorporate A Beka, Frog Street Press, Hand Writing Without Tears and Zoo Phonics curriculum into our program to provide a variety of ways of learning the Bible, phonics, letters, colors, shapes, math and science.

**SPIRITUAL:** Your child will begin to understand the love and acceptance of Jesus towards all people as we demonstrate God's love to your child. Christian principles are essential in providing children with a sound foundation for their future growth. Our Christian curriculum teaches that the Bible is the written Word of God and the way for their lives to be patterned.

**COGNITIVE:** We encourage an enthusiasm for learning and a sense of accomplishment in mastering skills for school. Your child will be encouraged to build skills in listening, language development, understand concepts related to size, shape, space, color, and distance. Reading and math readiness skills will be practiced. Your child will be given the opportunity to reason, discover and experiment.

**PHYSICAL:** We recognize the need to provide an age appropriate physical environment for each child, and have designed a safe and fun environment to meet their physical activeness. We have 15 minutes of outside play each day to help build large motor skills.

**MENTAL:** We strive to provide children with a safe, secure, learning environment to develop their emerging skills. We recognize that you are your child's first and most important teacher and feel it is important for parents to be part of their child's growth. Therefore, we will keep parents informed of their child's progress and activities and strive to provide ways for parents to be active in the school.

**SOCIAL:** We provide channels by which children are able to experience positive ways to develop socially through basic Christian concepts. Your child will continue develop a caring attitude toward others and develop self-discipline through learning to make wise choices.

**EMOTIONAL:** Your child will develop positive self-concept, learning to love and accept others as he or she is loved and accepted. This preschool will help your child learn to verbally express both positive and negative feelings appropriately.

**DEVELOPMENTAL:** We believe that the majority of a child's learning foundation is established at a young age. We focus on this concept by providing a learning environment that is developmentally age appropriate. We provide hands on learning environments that allow exploration and discovery through the use of the five senses.
